


# Posterior-Inferior Retractors

## Designed for Total Hip Surgery

The posterior-inferior retractor is placed with the point at 6 o' clock and the retractor's axilla resting on the ischium. The remaining blade of this retractor is used to retract the remaining capsule from the posterior lip of the acetabulum. The small 7625-01 & 7625-02 feature a toothed inner arc for a better grip.
